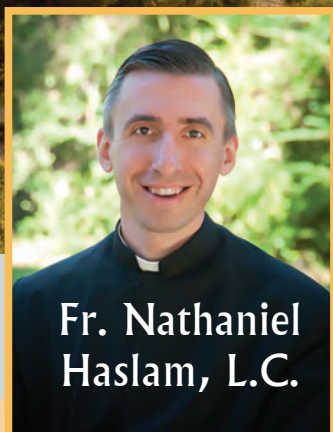

10 Days Pilgrimage To The Holy Land

DAY 1: June 1, 2019: Depart USA

Depart USA on overnight flights to Tel Aviv, Israel.

DAY 2: June 2, 2019: Arrive Tel Aviv | Sea of Galilee

Arrive in Tel Aviv and meet your Guide of the whole trip, then transfer by private motor coach to the Sea of Galilee and check into the hotel in Tiberias.

Mass will be celebrated after dinner at the Hotel.

Dinner and overnight at Ron Beach Hotel in Tiberias. (D)

DAY 3: June 3, 2019: Mount Tabor | Cana | Nazareth

This morning visit the Church of the Beatitudes and the area where Christ preached the Sermon on the Mount. Then drive to Mount Tabor where Jesus met Moses and Elijah at the Transfiguration. Continue to the town of Cana in Galilee where married couples will have the chance to renew their wedding vows at the site of the first miracle of Jesus. Travel to Nazareth and celebrate **Mass** at the Basilica of the Annunciation; visit the grotto where the Incarnation took place.

Lunch at Tanureen Restaurant in Tiberias.

Dinner and overnight at Ron Beach Hotel in Tiberias. (B / L / D)

DAY 4: June 4, 2019: Banias | Tabgha | Magdala Center

After breakfast, depart north to Banias (Caesarea Philippi) where Jesus anointed Peter as the first Pope. Travel back down to Galilee to visit Kursi, where the demons were cast from the Gadarenes. Then travel to Tabgha where Jesus multiplied the loaves and fishes. Later stop at Magdala to see the excavation site of the town that was home to St. Mary Magdala. Celebrate **Mass** at the Main Chapel of the Magdala Center on the Sea of Galilee.

Lunch at Katze Hanahal Restaurant in Tiberias.

Dinner and overnight at Ron Beach Hotel in Tiberias. (B / L / D)

DAY 5: June 5, 2019: Capernaum | Sea of Galilee | Jerusalem

Today walk the banks of the Sea of Galilee and take a boat ride to visit Capernaum. See the ancient synagogue where Jesus taught about eating his Flesh and Blood in John's Eucharistic discourse. Onto the Church of the Primacy of Peter where we celebrate **Mass**. Then, travel south, through the Jordan Valley. Along the way see many biblical sites; look across to Moses' Mount Nebo, see Jericho through the Judean Wilderness and the tree of Zacchaeus and we will climb by cable car to Mt. of Temptation. Continue to Jerusalem for hotel check-in.

Lunch at Rawda Restaurant in Jericho.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B / L / D)



DAY 6: June 6, 2019: Jerusalem

Early morning walk the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow) and pray the Stations of the Cross ending at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher to celebrate our Holy **Mass** at Calvary or Tomb of Christ (subject to confirmation). Return for breakfast then take a walking tour of the Old City on the way to the Western Wall. Travel back in time to "see" the Temple as it was seen by Mary and Jesus. Enter St. Stephen's Gate and visit the Church of St. Anne where Mary was born. See the Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed a lame man. After lunch on your own visit Mount Zion, the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu ("where the cock crowed") and walk the Roman steps. Visit the Upper Room (Cenacle), and Dormition Abbey, where Mary "fell asleep." After lunch we will drive to visit the Israel Museum Shrine of the book and the Model of Holy Land.

Lunch at Notre Dame Center.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B / L / D)



DAY 7: June 7, 2019: Bethlehem | Ein Karem

Breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a drive to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity to see the cave where Jesus was born and we will visit the milk Grotto. Celebrate **Mass** at St. Jerome at the Nativity Church. Continue drive to visit the Shepherds Fields. After Lunch, travel to Ein Karem to visit the Churches of the Visitation and St. John the Baptist.

Lunch at Tent Restaurant in Bethlehem.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B / L / D)

DAY 8: June 8, 2019: Mt. of Olives | Garden of Gethsemane

Drive to the Mount of Olives and visit the Chapel of the Ascension where Jesus rose into heaven – Pater Noster and Dominus Flevit - visit the Garden of Gethsemane for a group Holy Hour and private prayer in the Grotto of the Arrest. Celebrate **Mass** at the Church of all Nations at the Garden of Gethsemane.





Lunch at Notre Dame Center.

Free afternoon. Early evening we will visit the Museum of the Shroud of turin at Notre Dame.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B / L / D)

DAY 9: June 9, 2019: Bethany – Baptismal Site – Qumran – Dead Sea

After breakfast we will drive to Bethany to visit the church and the Tomb of St. Lazarus – Holy **Mass** in Bethany . we will then drive to the Baptismal site at the Jordan River – Qasr El – Yehud , and renew baptismal vows in the Jordan River at the site of the Lord's baptism. From here we drive to the Dead Sea area to see the caves at Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were hidden. Visit the archeological site and see three-dimensional movie about the place. Drive further south along the Dead Sea and stop in place for a swim in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties.

Lunch will be today at Qumran Restaurant.

Farwell Dinner at the 4th floor Restaurant and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B / L / D)



DAY 10 : June 10, 2019: Jerusalem – Ben Gurion Airport.

Return home from Tel Aviv after a memorable spiritual journey in the Holy Land.

ITINERARY: The Itinerary as presented in this brochure is tentative and represents what we are planning for you, however it is subject to confirmations from many organizations. Because of changes in local schedules, we may need to alter specified events, dates and/or venues to better fit the overall plan. The right is reserved to alter or cancel the itinerary, at Via Emmaus sole discretion, as it may deem necessary or advisable.

ROOMS: Tour prices are per person according to a room type: a "Single" room is one person in a room and a "Double" is two persons in one room. Triples are one double bed with two persons sharing the bed and one single bed. Triples are not always available and are discouraged because of cramped quarters.

LUGGAGE: Baggage is at owner's risk throughout the tour.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Travelers must be medically and physically fit for this tour. This tour requires significant walking, as motor coaches are not permitted to pick up and drop off in front of major attractions.
