Use the following checklist to assemble your supply kit. Include other items as appropriate for you family.

7 day supply of water (1 gallon per person per day), replace every 3 months	Infant formula, baby food, diapers and other supplies
5-7 day supply of nonperishable food (for each family member), replace prior to expiration	☐ Prescription medications (1-week supply) and copies of prescriptions

Pain relievers for adults and children	Plastic sheeting and duct tape to create a shelter
