

TURKEY AND STUFFING OUICHE

A quiche is the perfect way to use leftover turkey and stuffing—and a little Cheddar

Ingredients

Crust:

One 9-inch frozen pie shell *Filling:*

1 cup crumbled leftover stuffing 1 cup chopped leftover turkey *

1 cup shredded sharp Cheddar

1/4 cup parsley leaves, roughly chopped Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper *Custard:*



Total: 1 hr 45 min (includes cook time) Prep: 25 min Inactive: 30 min Cook: 50 min 6 servings

1 1/4 cups half-and-half • 3 large eggs 1/4 teaspoon freshly grated nutmeg Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

Directions

Par-bake the crust according to package directions. Let cool slightly before adding the filling.

For the filling:

Sprinkle the stuffing and turkey in the par-baked shell. Top with the Cheddar and parsley. Season with a little salt and pepper.


For the custard:

Whisk together the half and half, eggs, nutmeg, 1/2 teaspoon salt and 1/4 teaspoon pepper in a medium bowl.

Pour the custard over the filling. Adjust the oven temperature to 350 degrees F and bake until set, 35 to 45 minutes. Let cool at least 30 minutes before serving warm or at room temperature.
