

## HORIZON CAMPAIGN UPDATE

- The Horizon Campaign began with \$823,000 in savings from the Greater Glory of God Campaign
- Together, we gathered \$6,890,000 in pledges from 1,275 donors (as of 8/31/21)
- So far, \$3,944,000 has been collected on those pledges (as of 8/31/21)
- The Our Lady of the Angels Chapel is estimated to cost \$6,500,000
- Our parish pledged \$2,600,000 to the Archdiocesan Ignite Campaign, of which \$814,000 has already been paid

While the \$6.5 million budget builds a serviceably furnished chapel, there will be opportunities for commemorative gifting to the chapel and reliquary to allow the Our Lady of the Angels worship space to be an even more beautiful, prayerful and holy site for our parishioners and pilgrims to enjoy.
