## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

---

1. **Recently issued baptismal certificate.** Call the Church where your baptized happened ("the church of record") and request a new baptismal certificate. Must be within the last 6 months.
2. **Copy of your Birth Certificate**
3. **Copy of your Marriage Certificate**, if married. Must be married in the Catholic Church prior to reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.
4. **Saint Name** you want for your Confirmation.
5. **Sponsor Form:** must be a devout Catholic who can attend the Rite of Confirmation

## MATERIALS FOR CLASS

---

1. **Revised Standard Version 2<sup>nd</sup> Catholic Edition:** I would love it if you bought the Ascension Press Great Adventure Bible, as it has salvation history outlined in essays, but the Ignatius Press hardcover is sufficient.
2. **Catechism of the Catholic Church:** you can get the big blue one, the big green one, or the smaller white one. It is all the same content for the most part.
3. **Pen and notebook:** I talk a lot and your questions matter. Write notes and keep questions handy!
4. **Binder or folder for Handouts:** I will have plenty of handouts for you.
