Adult Confirmation is for those who are baptized Roman Catholics, who did not receive their Confirmation when younger. To join our Adult Confirmation class, you must be 18 years old and no longer in high school. Confirmation formation is done at St. Anthony's, but the sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated with the bishop through the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston.

The celebration of Confirmation is tentatively scheduled for the weekend of May 27/28, **2023.** (Specific dates TBD by Archdiocese).

MATERIALS NEEDED

- **1. Bible Revised Standard Version, 2nd Catholic Edition**: I would love it if you bought the Ascension Press Great Adventure Bible (ISBN 978-1945179419), as it has salvation history outlined in essays, but the Ignatius Press hardcover (ISBN 978-0898708332) is sufficient.
- **2. Catechism of the Catholic Church**: you can get the big blue one (ISBN 978-1601376497) or the smaller paperback (ISBN 978-0385479851). Ascension Press also has a version with a lot of extra features (ISBN 978-1954881648).
- **3. Pen and notebook**: I talk a lot and your questions matter. Write notes and keep questions handy!
- **4. Binder or folder for Handouts**: I will have plenty of handouts for you.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1. Recently-issued Baptismal Certificate. Call the Church where you were baptized ("the church of record") and request a NEW copy of your baptismal certificate. Must be within the 6 months of your Confirmation date (May 2023).
- 2. Copy of your Birth Certificate.
- 3. Copy of your Marriage Certificate, if married in the Catholic Church. This is the certificate issued by the Catholic Church where you were married. This is NOT the state-issued marriage license. If you don't have a copy on hand, you can contact the Catholic church where you were married and ask them to issue a new certificate. If you are married, but were not married in the Catholic Church, you must have your marriage convalidated prior to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- **4. Saint Name Form.** This the name of the saint you will choose to be your patron. It should be a recognized saint of the Catholic Church or a person from Scripture. A link to this form will be sent to you and completed online.
- **5. Sponsor Form.** Your sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, who is at least 16 years of age and has received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. If your sponsor is married, he/she must be married in the Catholic Church. Your father or mother cannot serve as your sponsor. Finally, your sponsor should be present with you at the Rite of Reception when you receive your sacraments. A link to the sponsor form will be sent to you and completed online.
