REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1. Recently-issued Baptismal Certificate.
 Contact the Church where you were baptized ("the church of record") and request a NEW copy of your baptismal certificate with sacramental notations. The issue date must be within the 6 months of your Confirmation date (Jan 2024).
- 2. Copy of your Birth Certificate.
- 3. Copy of your Marriage Certificate, if married in the Catholic Church. This is the certificate issued by the Catholic church where you were married (NOT the state-issued marriage license). If you don't have a copy on hand, you can contact the Catholic church where you were married and ask them to issue a new certificate. If you are married, but were not married in the Catholic Church, you must have your marriage convalidated prior to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. - 4. **Saint Name Form.** This is the name of the saint you will choose to be your patron. It should be a recognized saint of the Catholic Church or a person from Scripture. This form will be completed online.
- 5. **Sponsor Form.** Your sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, who is at least 16 years of age and has received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. If your sponsor is married, he/she must be married in the Catholic Church. Your father or mother cannot serve as your sponsor. Your sponsor must be present with you at the Rite of Confirmation when you receive your sacraments. This form will be completed online.
