Hearty Chicken Gyros Prep: 30 min + marinating Cook: 5 min. 6 servings lingredients 1-1/2 pounds boneless skinless chicken breasts, cut into 1/2-inch cubes

1/2 cup salt-free lemon-pepper marinade 3 tablespoons minced fresh mint sauce: •1/2 cup fat-free plain Greek yogurt 2 tablespoons lemon juice

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder Assembly:

1 medium cucumber, seeded and chopped

1 medium tomato, chopped 1/4 cup finely chopped onion 6 whole wheat pita pocket halves, warmed 1/3 cup crumbled feta cheese



Directions

- 1. Place chicken, marinade and mint in a shallow dish and turn to coat. Cover and refrigerate up to 6 hours.
- 2. Drain chicken, discarding marinade. Place a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add chicken; cook and stir until no longer pink, 4-6 minutes.
- 3. In a small bowl, mix sauce ingredients. In another bowl, combine cucumber, tomato and onion. Serve chicken in pita pockets with sauce, vegetable mixture and cheese.

(Mint Sauce)

1 cup mint leaves - 1 Tablespoon Granulated Sugar 1/4 cup white wine vinegar

Place washed mint leaves with the sugar in a bowl in a small saucepan -heat the vinegar over low heat. Pour the vinegar over the mint. Taste and add more sugar if you think the sauce is too sharp
