★ **JASON HANA: Lady Bird Deeds and Trusts**

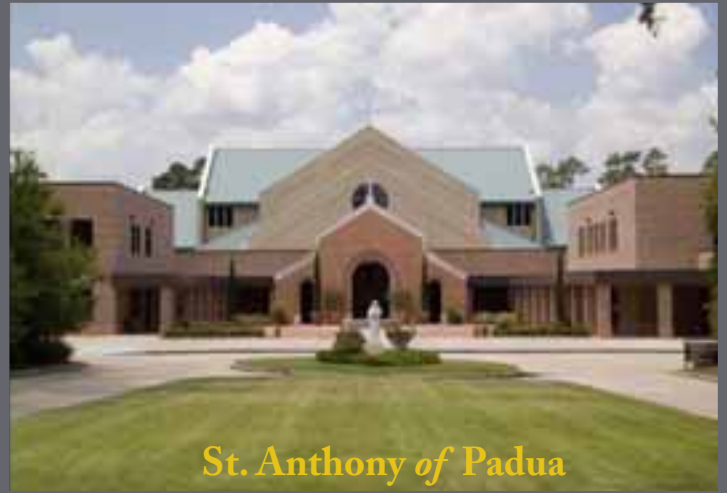

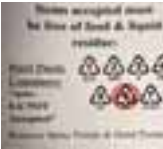
